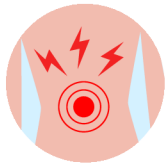


Main Symptoms of Schistosomiasis

CHRONIC ABDOMINAL OR PELVIC PAIN



BLOOD IN URINE (HAEMATURIA)



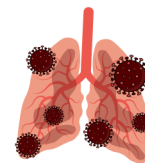
PAIN OR BURNING WHEN URINATING



RECURRENT URINARY TRACT INFECTIONS



DIARRHOEA, CONSTIPATION OR BLOOD IN STOOL



PERSISTENT COUGH AND/OR CHRONIC BRONCHITIS
